The Website: continues to provide valuable information and was well used during the 2010 registration. Recently we uploaded an article from the Alliance regarding "Official Marks". Official marks are words that have been registered with the Canadian Intellectual Property Office, through the federal Trade-marks Act. The Canadian Alliance of Physiotherapy Regulators has the authority for the use of official marks throughout Canada for the profession that includes both practice words (e.g. physiotherapy and physical therapy) and title words (e.g. physical therapist, physiotherapist and PT). It is important to note that these official marks are intended for Public Protection and as such you as a practitioner should review this article so as to insure you use these words appropriately on signs, business cards and advertisements etc. The article can be found under the Standards, Policy, etc. tab. www.nsphysio.com
