

C Registration information for the applicants who have completed the PCE and not yet worked:

- Graduate of a Canadian, or non-Canadian, University Physiotherapy Degree Program
- Completed both the QE /Part 1 and the Clinical /Part 2 components of the Physiotherapy Competency Exam (PCE)
- Not previously employed as a physiotherapist in Canada

And are

- A Canadian citizen or are legally entitled to work in Canada.

You must complete the [Initial Registration Form](#) for licensure in the Nova Scotia College of Physiotherapists (NSCP) and **return the completed form along with the following:**

1. A notarized copy of your physiotherapy diploma/degree
2. A photocopy of your birth certificate/ Working Visa /passport
3. A cheque, money order or Visa/MasterCard number for the current registration fee as appropriate in Canadian funds.
4. Proof of Malpractice Insurance
5. Un-mounted passport size photograph
6. Updated Resume/Curriculum Vitae with a chronological listing of previous education & employment, including a description of your clinical and non-clinical experience
7. Proof of successful completion of the Physiotherapy National Exam (PCE) as required by the NSCP.
